## JULY 1 DEADLINE FOR QUILT OF GLASS

EUREKA – Community members have less than four weeks left to buy tiles for the Quilt of Glass that will be unveiled at the grand opening of the New Alzheimer’s Center, currently being constructed on California Street in Eureka across from the Humboldt Senior Resource Center.

July 1 is the deadline to purchase tiles for this unique permanent installation, which will be a “quilt” made of 500 2.5-by-5-inch recycled glass tiles created by Arcata-based Fire & Light. For a \$100 donation, community members can have a tile customized with a two-line engraving.

“The tiles are a beautiful, permanent gift,” said Roz Keller, fund development coordinator at HSRC. “They are also a lovely way to honor a friend or family member or remember a loved one.”

The tiles, in a variety of Fire & Light hues, will be installed by Carbonneau Ceramic Tile on the second floor of the New Alzheimer’s Center at the entryway to the resource library, creating a patchwork of color and light. The installation will be revealed at the grand opening of the New Alzheimer’s Center, which is slated for the beginning of 2009.

Additional tiles will be sold for future quilts in the building, but July 1 is the deadline to be part of this special grand opening installation. Only 350 tiles remain for this first quilt.
