Adult Day Health is a therapeutic day program that provides care to enhance the independence and quality of life for adults with physical and mental disabilities. We also provide respite for family caregivers.

Adult Day Health is licensed by the state of California and staff is professionally licensed and trained to provide quality care.

Our services include:

- Individualized therapeutic care
- Physical, occupational, and speech therapies
- Nursing supervision of medications, medical care, and treatments
- Full spectrum of personal care services
- Daily snack and hot lunches with input from a registered dietician
- Information and caregiver support services provided by social workers
