Activities Program

The Activities Program provides information, education, and recreation for seniors, families, and caregivers in Humboldt County.

Services include Senior Firewood, flu shots, health consultations, tax assistance, support groups, commodity food distribution, computer lab, and a library.

Classes promoting healthy aging include Tai Chi, STRONG exercise, yoga, karate, arthritis exercise, and line dancing.

HSRC provides applications and ticket sales for the door-to-door shared cab and wheelchair lift van service.

Are You OK?®

Are You OK? is a telephone reassurance service for residents in the greater Eureka area. This service provides daily check-ins and peace of mind for elders who live alone.

Senior Home Repair

Minor safety repairs are available to eligible residents of Eureka. Services can include basic plumbing and electrical work, installing/repairing railings, safety bars, and other safety concerns.
