We provide the following for qualified patients:

- Individual counseling
- Group counseling
- Substance use counseling
- Therapeutic case management
- Psychiatric medication evaluations*
- Psychiatric medication management*

Who Is Eligible For HSRC's Behavioral Health Services?

Any adult age 55 and older who resides in Humboldt County and who wishes to engage in therapy to address issues in their lives is eligible to receive services. Examples of qualifying issues include personal concerns, mental health challenges, or stress.



Where Are Behavioral Health Services Provided?

Counseling and services can be provided in a setting that is most comfortable for the client, and our staff can come to you. This provides a variety of setting options including, but not limited to:

- In the BHS offices
- In-home
- In a community setting – including group sessions, if desired
- Via telehealth, such as videoconferencing (subject to insurance approval)

We work with each client to determine what treatment setting meets their needs.

The Behavioral Health Care Team

The Behavioral Health Services program is staffed by a team of behavioral health professionals and support personnel.

Cost

In addition, private pay is accepted. We also offer sliding scale payment options based on the patient's income level.
