



What Is MSSP?

MSSP is a statewide, community-based care management program offered through the Humboldt Senior Resource Center and funded by state and federal agencies.

MSSP helps eligible older adults live at home by delaying or preventing placement in a skilled nursing facility.

MSSP provides an experienced Care Manager to meet with you and your family to assess your needs, and who provides long-term help with arranging the services you require. Your Care Manager will contact you monthly and will offer continuous support.

Is There a Cost for MSSP Services?

There is no cost for this service, which is paid by the federal government and the State of California.

Who Qualifies for MSSP?

- Persons 65 years of age or older
- Medi-Cal recipients
- Those at risk of placement in a skilled nursing facility due to health needs
- Residents of Humboldt County
- Those willing to work with a Care Manager on mutually agreed-upon goals

The MSSP Care Manager:

- Provides information
- Performs in-home assessments and assists in locating and coordinating services
- Monitors the delivery of services
- Advocates for the participant

The MSSP Participant:

- Participates in identifying service needs and developing a plan to meet those needs
- Works with the Care Manager and community service providers, and communicates with the Care Manager about their concerns
