Description

This presentation will cover how Parkinson-Plus syndromes share symptoms with Parkinson's disease; however, the symptoms have different underlying causes for the disease and do not respond to typical Parkinson's disease treatment. This talk will cover the clinical side and disease characteristics several Parkinson's Plus syndromes have, as well as current treatments.

About the speaker

Dr. Levine is a scientist and clinician and holds an appointment as Adjunct Professor with the Department of Neurology at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA.

He is a board-certified clinical neuropsychologist through the American Board of Professional Psychology. He has been involved in clinical and medico-legal practice and consultation since completing a post-doctoral fellowship at the UCLA Neuropsychiatric Institute in 2005. He is a Qualified Medical Examiner for the California Department of Workers' Compensation and FAA HIMS-certified neuropsychologist.
