Multipurpose Senior Services Program (MSSP)

MSSP is a community-based care management program that helps eligible older adults locate and manage supportive services. These services help them to remain in their own homes as long as possible with a higher quality of life. To be eligible, one must be 65 or older, receive Medi-Cal benefits, live in Humboldt County, be in need of services coordination to avoid residential or skilled nursing care placement, and be willing to accept services.

Redwood Coast PACE
