She has practiced in the Humboldt community for over 20 years, including as a hospitalist and hospice physician.

She has special interest in geriatrics, palliative and end-of-life care, as well as decreasing inequities in health care. She serves on the National PACE Association's rural ethics and political advocacy committees. She also completed a fellowship in contemplative medicine through the New York Zen Center for Contemplative Care.
