Program / Service Overview	Administration functions include Communications & Marketing, Finance, Human Resources and Operations/ Facilities. <i>Senior News</i> is a monthly community newspaper focusing on stories, news and resources for those "age 50 and better."	The Community Resources and Housing Specialist helps connect those at risk of losing shelter with available housing options. This position also connects community members with resources they need, whether at HSRC or at another community organization.	Redwood Coast Village is a membership program that helps members be independent with the help of volunteer-provided services. A range of services and activities are offered including rides, light help around the house, safety repairs, social connections, and more.	Activities provides information, education, and recreation. Services include the "My Safety Call" telephone reassurance program, PETS (Paws, Ears, Tails and Smiles), flu shots, tax assistance, commodity food distribution, and more. Classes and groups promote healthy aging.	The Nutrition Program provides nutritious meals at Heritage Café locations in Arcata, Eureka, and Fortuna and pop-up locations in McKinleyville and Rio Dell. The program offers "more than just a meal" — diners also can enjoy opportunities for friendship, socialization, and fun.	Meals on Wheels Redwood Coast provides meals to homebound older adults. The program's drivers also check on the wellness of the recipients on their routes. For some participants, the delivery driver is the only contact they may have that day or even that week.	Behavioral Health Services, a holistic approach to wellness, focuses on how social, emotional and physical domains interact with factors such as family, health care and housing to affect an individual's overall well-being.	Adult Day Health serves those who have chronic conditions and disabilities, providing nursing, therapies, activities, social services, lunch, and transportation to and from the Center. Alzheimer's Services provides consultations, resources, and support for families and caregivers.	MSSP is a care management program for adults age 65 and older on Medi-Cal and who are at risk of placement in a skilled nursing facility. MSSP helps arrange services that will enable clients to remain in their own homes for as long as possible.	Redwood Coast PACE is a health plan for qualified older adults who have chronic conditions or disabilities. PACE provides comprehensive health care and support services that help participants stay as healthy and independent as possible, optimally in their homes and community.
