My Safety Call

My Safety Call is a telephone reassurance service provided by the Humboldt Senior Resource Center in partnership with Arcata Fire District and Humboldt Bay Fire for residents in the greater Arcata, Eureka, and McKinleyville areas.

Here's how it works:

- Each morning, at a pre-arranged time, the *My Safety Call* system automatically calls subscribers.
- If no response is received or noted by the *My Safety Call* computer after three calls, an alert is created and an HSRC or City Ambulance staff member will call the subscriber's emergency contact. Then, if needed, local fire district personnel will be notified to initiate a welfare check.

To enroll in HSRC's *My Safety Call* service, subscribers must:

- Live within the Arcata or Humboldt Bay fire districts,
- Be able to answer the telephone, and
- Provide a house key to be kept in a secure locked key box that's accessible only by local fire district personnel.

There is a minimal one-time registration fee of \$12. The lock box is loaned to subscribers free of charge.
